India Pilgrimage Letter #5

Fellow Pilgrim,

As our pilgrimage to India nears, it is important to internalize our purpose for going. El Morya addresses this: *“Now blessed ones, let me tell you what this pilgrimage will mean for the Earth. The light that we intend to anchor through your physical presence, one with us, will stabilize the area of Southeast Asia such that the greater plans for violence, terror, war, chaos and insanity will be thwarted and consumed. It will allow an army of cosmic beings entrée to your world*



through the emanation of the eternal frequencies of the cosmic AUM that you will witness tangibly. It will also be a landmark statement to the Lords of Karma that a holy band of our intrepid ones has set their seal upon India once more, creating a new bridge of light between the East and the West that you may then traverse daily in your ongoing meditations with us. For having come physically to our home of light, a living trail of the very substance of your soul and your spirit emanations will be left in the ethers. And this you may continue to breathe and to focus light through wherever you are, blessed hearts.

“Each night during the pilgrimage your soul will take flight to Darjeeling, and you will receive a continuous outpouring of inner darshan and blessing from us in your finer bodies that is just as important for your soul’s eternal flight as what you will receive in the outer. For we will be working with all of your spiritual bodies and conforming them to the one eternal body of Brahma, Vishnu and Shiva who will from that day forward be manifest tangibly within your heart if you fully accept it. This inner teaching, this initiation of which I have spoken will only be given to those attending the pilgrimage or those who have sponsored others to attend.”

Flights/Passport and Visas

Our India Tour Agency, Mosaic India Tours Pvt. Ltd. requires the name of the airline, arrival time in New Delhi, passport number with place and date of issue (for U.S. citizens under place of issue just put “state” plus your India visa number with place of issue (there are many different Indian consulates) and expiry date. This information is required of each pilgrim traveling on this pilgrimage. Most of us will be arriving in New Delhi on either Continental #82 arriving 8:15 p.m. or Air India #102 arriving 4:45 p.m. on October 15th. However, others of our group are coming from Sweden, Australia and other flights from the states. Here is a list of the information we need from each of you:

Providing your arrival airline name, flight number and arrival time allows our travel agent to see that your flight is met with an appropriately-sized vehicle. The balance of the information is required by each hotel in which we will stay while in India. By having this information in advance, our travel agent can handle our hotel registration prior to our arrival and keep our hotel check in time at 15 minutes rather than 2 hours.

I would like to receive this information from each of you by Thursday, September 4th.

Visa

As I have mentioned in previous letters, it is important to secure your India visa as soon as possible. I had recommended http://www.americanpassport.com/India_Tourist_visa.php in the earlier letters and subsequently referred you to www.travisaindia.com as an option. Travisaindia is managed by the India Consulate and covers all nations. You can use either passport service, the difference being the handling fee. Americanpassport charges \$55 while travisaindia charges \$20. You may also go in person to an Indian consulate. One question on the visa application asks the name and address of where you are staying or your travel agency. Our travel agent is: Mosaic India Tours Pvt. Roommates

Many of you have already decided on your roommate. I would appreciate your letting me know so that I can produce a list with roommates and another list of those who are looking for a roommate. I will then make the latter list available to those seeking a roommate so that we can get paired up.

Weather and luggage

I know many of you are already wondering how you're going to get everything you feel you need on this pilgrimage into one (1) piece of checked luggage with a maximum weight of 50# and one (1) piece of carry on! It is doable! The weather is extremely favorable in India during the month of October. It's the dry season and daytime temperatures will run 75-80 degrees and the evenings 60-65 degrees. Other than summer attire, all you need is a light jacket or wrap. Also, for those who would like to purchase casual Indian clothing—this is not a requirement—to wear while in India, we'll make time for this the first day.

Research

This is the time to read everything you can find on India. The more you know about the history and culture of India, the more you will get out of the pilgrimage and the more the masters can release while we're on the pilgrimage. I would highly recommend starting with "The Masters and their Retreats" published by S.U. Press. Learn which masters have retreats in the Himalayas and study their lives. Knowing of their embodiments will bring India to life for you!
