

**North American Union—The Security and Prosperity
Partnership
Canada’s Bill C-51 and Bill C-52
Latest Steps in the Integration Timeline for Canada,
the United States and Mexico**

PART I

By the power of my threefold flame, I call for Canada’s Parliament to defend my freedoms and defeat Bill C-51, and I call for the following manifestations to remain or occur:

1. Citizens retain free choice in determining their health care. They make their own personal health decisions regarding Natural Health Products (NHPs) and are not forced by “police state” regulations to rely upon pharmaceuticals.

2. NHPs remain on the shelves unless the government can prove they are unsafe.

3. Warrants are required for Health Canada to enter a place of business and seize NHPs.

4. Manufacturers, merchants and natural health practitioners stay in business because Health Canada stops trying to rewrite legislation to increase its inspection and seizure powers, to increase its ability to impose high fines and to require the business owners to pay the cost of seizure, transport and storage.

5. Product prices are kept as low as possible because government has not closed down small businesses.

6. Food, drugs and natural health care products are defined separately in the Food and Drug Act. Drugs and natural health care products are not lumped together under the term “therapeutic products,” and the Food and Drug Act name is not changed to Food and Therapeutic Products Act.

7. Items such as vitamins, herbs, blueberries and garlic are not classified as illegal drugs.

8. Citizens maintain their health by purchasing NHPs with their own money, which also provides the added benefit of saving taxpayers’ money in healthcare systems.

9. Citizens give NHPs to friends and children without fear of being fined.

10. Researchers study the benefits of NHPs without having to obtain government permission.

11. The 20,000 products removed from Canadian shelves since 2004 are restored.

12. Parliament must approve all international trade agreements (e.g. Codex) before they are permitted to become law in Canada and to prevent confidential information from being shared with foreign governments and agencies.

13. NHPs are covered under health care plans and insurance plans to the same amount of money that drugs are covered.

14. Vitamins, NHPs and preventative medicine procedures are tax-deductible in order to save money in health care by encouraging prevention of disease and by encouraging people to be proactive in taking care of their health.

15. Doctors are allowed to give NHP samples to their patients as well as drug samples.

PART 2

By the power of my threefold flame, I call for Canada's Parliament to defend my freedoms and to defeat Bill C-52, and I call for the following manifestations to remain or occur:

1. The current law which protects consumer safety remains.
2. Procedural safeguards citizens currently enjoy remain.
3. The law of trespass remains which disallows the State access onto private property.
4. The State is denied rights to seize property without a Court order, without reporting the seizure to a Court and for an indefinite period.
5. The State is not allowed to assume control over the movement of private property without a Court order and without a safety concern.
6. The government does not violate the right found in section 8 of the Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms to be free from unreasonable search and seizure.
7. Persons charged with administrative violations have the right to have a Court determine their guilt or innocence, not the Minister of Health. There is defence of due diligence or of honest but mistaken belief. There must be a safety risk to be charged with an administrative offence. Seized property cannot be kept from a person if found guilty.

PART 3

By the power of my threefold flame, I call for the Canadian government to take the following steps regarding the North American Union:

1. Cease all talks leading toward deeper integration between Canada and the United States, including annual Security and Prosperity Partnership summits.

2. Disband the North American Competitiveness Council. Corporations such as Manulife Financial, Suncor, Procter & Gamble and Lockheed Martin should not be writing economic, environmental and security policy on behalf of the Canadian and American governments.

3. Bring the Security and Prosperity Partnership to the House of Commons for a full debate and vote. The Harper government has promised that, "significant international treaties will be submitted for votes in Parliament."

4. Disclose the complete listing of Security and Prosperity Partnership working groups, their contact persons and participating membership, and, if they continue, make public their meeting dates, minutes, and provide opportunities for public input.

5. Consult with Canadians in a meaningful and participatory way on Canada-U.S. relations. The majority of Canadians support independent policies that protect our health and the environment, and safeguard our energy and civil liberties, over an agreement that puts corporate profits first.

Notes: There is no good reason why Canadians should be kept in the dark about issues as important as the economic and social future of our country. Corporations certainly shouldn't be drafting government policy behind closed doors. Most of our elected officials do not understand the extent of deep integration and have not had a chance to vote on the Security and Prosperity Partnership of North America. Big corporations are

currently setting the parameters and timeline for Canada-U.S. integration without our approval. This cannot continue.

Bill C-51 is an Act to amend the Food and Drugs Act and to make consequential amendments to other Acts. Bill C-52 is an Act respecting the safety of consumer products. They are the

latest of many steps which have already been taken to move forward the Security and Prosperity Partnership (SPP, also known as the North American Union), an informal agreement among Canada, the United States and Mexico created for the purpose of streamlining activities among the countries and which avoids Parliamentary debate on their decisions. It makes agreements regarding health, food, drugs, security, manufacturing, immigration and the environment that bypass Canada's own law-making process.
