

Registration is now open for our next Meru University Class # 601 Leadership in the New Age: Challenges and Opportunities taught by Michael McNeil and Paul Haugen with dictations from El Morya.

This course will explore the challenges and opportunities of leaders and leaders-in- training as we enter the 21st century and discuss questions such as:

- What can be learned from the lives and words of the greatest leaders and teachers of the past and present?
- What views and characteristics have shaped our thinking about leaders and leadership in the 20th century? The 21st Century?
- What are the most significant characteristics of effective leaders? How does secular leadership compare to that of the religious leader?
- What is the relationship of leadership to management and administration?
- Why is it important to understand leadership as a dynamic process that changes?
- What can I do to be a more effective leader when facing change, conflict, or other challenges?

Even if you don't think you have leadership potential, God thinks otherwise and is calling you to rise to this challenge.
