FREEDOM 2006 ***"Gratitude for Freedom's Flame, Increasing Hearts' Fires East and West"*** is fast approaching! If you have not registered there is still time. It is also time to review your planning. For lodging you've likely made your choice of the Sioux Lodge condo, a hotel room in the Teewinot lodge (both at the resort) or a space at the campgrounds. Driggs, the last town prior to driving up the mountain, does have a large super-market.

Registration opens 9:00 a.m. on Friday, June 30<sup>th</sup>. Keep in mind that the Grand Targhee Resort is at 8,000 feet. The days will be hot and the nights very cool. Layer your clothing, so you can adjust to temperature and weather changes.

The afternoons offer a range of choices from disc golf, to Shakespeare, to networking (publishing, prayer/deed leading, preparedness, marketing and more), Foot Zonology, swimming, hiking, martial arts, napping, socializing, biking and the list goes on and on. Saturday night is under the Big Sky around the fire pit with Freedom songs and mantras. Monday evening is Saint Germain's "Jolly Follies"; a talent show for all ages. Start planning your act! And Tuesday's 4<sup>th</sup> of July picnic is scheduled for the mountain top at 10,000 feet via the chair lift.

On September 15<sup>th</sup> of last year, beloved Saint Germain said; *"Beloved Ones, you have found the jewel (Grand Targhee Resort) that we desire to use...for many Buddhas do desire to come and speak to you, for other than the event at Lake Titicaca, this will be the highest point where you have gathered thus far in recent years in large numbers. 33 dictations, many of them from Buddhas, will be received from the Ascended Masters during the five day conference with many hours of sacred service.*
