Dear Heartfriends,

Starting this **Saturday, March 1, 2008** access to our **vigils and evening services** will happen through logging-in to our site, a very easy process. Remember that you must be registered to be able to log in and that registering is a one-time process. To register, go to the home page and look in the right hand corner at the very top above the "The Hearts Center Community" title. You will see the words Register and Login in small print. Click on the word "Register" (it may take a few minutes for the registration page to appear). Supply the brief information requested on the registration page. You may use the same user name and password that you created for Store purchases. If you would like to register now, go to the home page at <http://www.heartscenter.org>.



Now you are ready to log in to our site in order to join a live broadcast by following these steps:

1. Click on "login" to the right of "register" on the homepage. These fields are above the word "Community" of "The Hearts Center Community" logo.
2. Type in your user name and password on the login page.
3. Click the gray "Login" button.
4. Your name will appear in the upper right-hand corner of the page if you have successfully logged-in.
5. After the page changes, you will be able to see if a service is currently broadcasting. If it is, you will see the pink broadcast box announcing ON AIR or OFF AIR. As you have done in the past, once it says ON AIR, click on "Go to Live Broadcast" in the broadcast announcement box and then on "Click Here to Listen Live" on the broadcast page. Although you will not lose your connection to the broadcast, you get automatically logged out if you have not accessed the website for over 30 minutes. If the top right of the website says "Login" rather than your name, please go back to step 1 and repeat.

So from **March 1, 2008** forward, all evening and vigil services will be accessible only after you have logged in. The Early Bird service, morning rosary and Sunday family service will continue to be available to everyone.

We are grateful for your understanding and support of the masters' desire for more professional and meaningful public broadcasts for those new to our teachings.
